

CKI DUES STRUCTURE

All CKI Clubs are expected to pay annual dues to the International and District between October 1st and November 1st each year. These dues, which support the services provided to members, are based on the size of the host institution and the nation where the CKI club is located. Dues can be paid through the [Membership Update Center](#).

Dues for CKI Clubs in Districted Nations:

- CKI Clubs at 4-year institutions with enrollment of 5,000 or more students pay a \$600 flat fee in international dues annually, plus district dues.
- CKI Clubs at 4-year institutions, with enrollment of less than 5,000 students pay a \$450 flat fee annually in international dues annually, plus district dues.
- CKI Clubs at a 2-year institution pay a \$300 flat fee annually in international dues, plus district dues.

Dues for International CKI Club in Non-Districted Nations:

- CKI clubs in Tier A nations pay a \$50 flat fee annually in international dues.
- CKI clubs in Tier B and C nations pay a \$25 flat fee annually in international dues.

Kiwanis International Tiers

As is done throughout the Kiwanis family of service clubs, nations are placed on tiers to ensure fairness when paying dues. Tiers are established by the Kiwanis International Board of Directors and are based off the Gross National Income figures released by the World Bank. They are broken down as follows:

- Tier A: Per Capita Income in that nation is \$10,000 per year in US dollars
- Tier B: Per Capita Income in that nation is between \$5,000 and \$9,999 per year in US dollars
- Tier C: Per Capita Income in that nations is below \$4,999 per year in US dollars Visit
